manifestation of God's greatness and magnificence

- 1. Glory IN GOD'S PRESENCE
- 2. Glory IN GOD'S REWARDS

JOY (chara)

true fulfillment and contentment regardless of circumstances; rooted in God's promises

GLORYIN GOD'S REWARDS

REWARDS IN HEAVEN

His master said to him, "Well done, good and faithful slave. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master."

MATTHEW 25:23

• Paul's motivation to labor in love was to please God

⁶ I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth. ⁷ So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but God who causes the growth.

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GOD CAUSES THE GROWTH

According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. But each man must be careful how he builds on it. 11 For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. ¹² Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, ¹³ each man's work will become evident;

for the day will show it because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work. ¹⁴ If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward.

Feels privileged to be entrusted as a steward of God's gospel and love



• Our crowns ultimately belong at the feet of God — the creator of it all!

• Paul was not concerned with gaining glory or affirmation for himself

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For am I now seeking the favor of men, or of God? Or am I striving to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a bond-servant of Christ.

1. Remember God's vision
